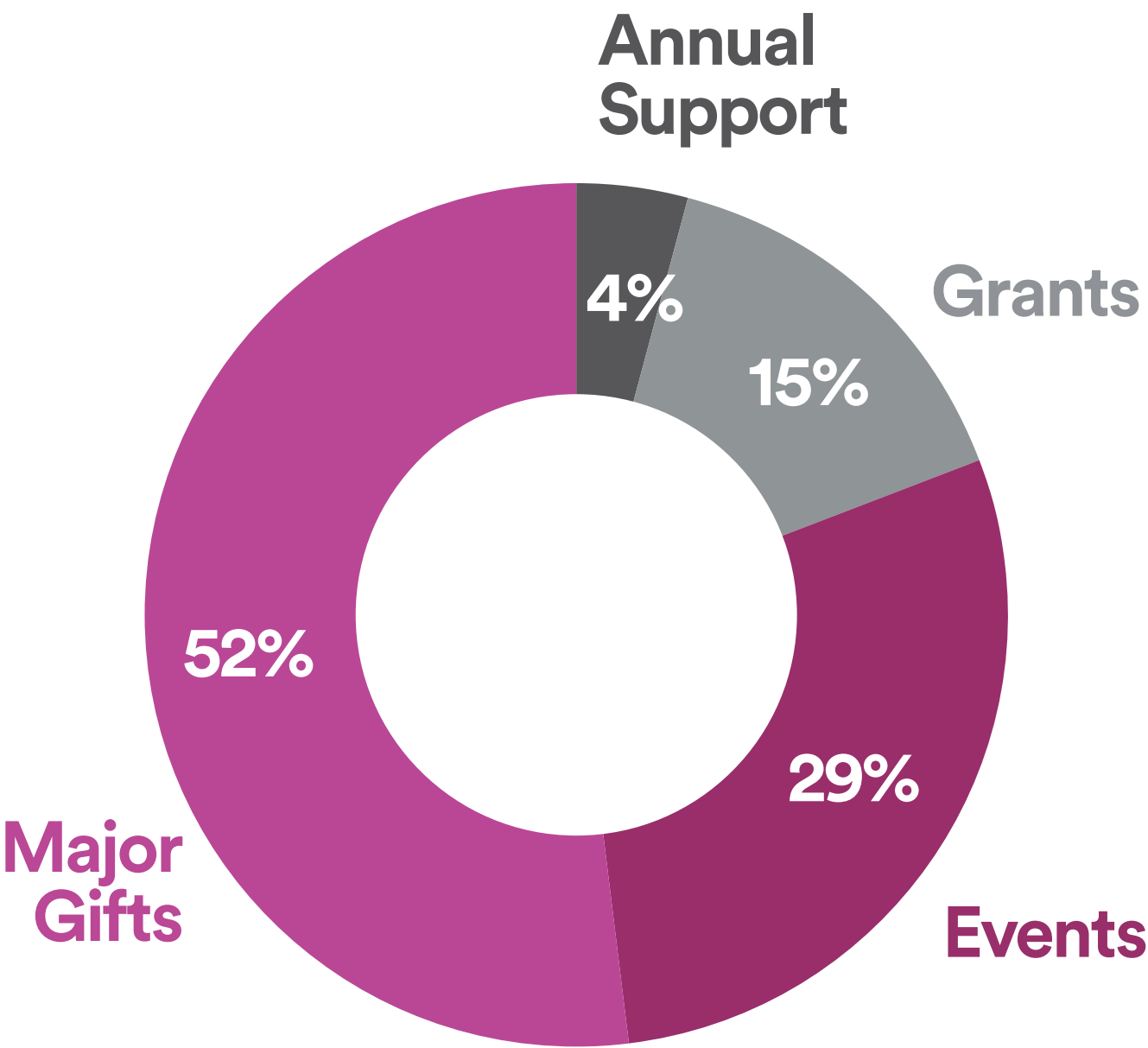

Dalton Blevins
Stewardship in Action



Dalton Blevins calls CommonSpirit—Memorial Hospital’s new Battlefield Parkway campus his “backyard.” As a local business owner, he’s focused on funding and promoting the project that his community has eagerly anticipated.

“I grew up, lived, worked, and played right here,” Dalton says. “This is my hometown and my community.”

As owner and president of Signal Industrial Solutions, Dalton strives to turn his success with business into an opportunity to serve North Georgia. He played a key role in fundraising for Memorial’s new campus.

“It’s nice to know that the families I have lived around my whole life have such close access to the hospital,” he says. “When I was contacted about supporting the effort here, it was a pretty easy yes. It aligns with taking care of people, and I love people.”

Dalton’s heart for health care is shared with his wife, Michelle. She formerly worked as a nurse with Memorial. The family considers their investment in the hospital as a stewardship opportunity.

“I tell everybody all the time, God has blessed us greatly,” says Dalton. “I want to be a good steward and invest in something that’s a need for humankind.”

Dalton worked closely with CommonSpirit Memorial Foundation staff to raise funds for the hospital. After his success with those efforts, he joined the foundation’s board in 2025, representing the North Georgia community.

Like many Catoosa County residents, Dalton is excited and relieved to have Memorial’s state-of-the-art services close by.

“There are times when five minutes matters,” he explains. Now, he says, patients don’t have to fight traffic and interstate congestion to get to a hospital.

He also appreciates the doctors’ offices and other clinicians that have opened near the hospital. He wants to work with other North Georgia business owners and encourage them to choose the new Memorial campus for their employee health care.

“The facility is just top-notch,” Dalton says. “It also has a warmth and an inviting atmosphere.”

To Dalton, the new campus is becoming a medical corridor in North Georgia. Other medical providers, businesses and even restaurants are opening in the area. The hospital’s easy access to interstates is also an advantage.

Memorial’s new campus is a reality because of all the investors and believers who supported the vision, according to Dalton. “This community will be better for it,” he explains.

Dalton believes in Memorial because its values align with his Christian faith. “Christ should be the center in all things,” he says. “That core value is at the root of who they are.”

“People for generations will thrive off the generosity of those donors.”

He also supports the hospital’s commitment to provide health care to everyone. “Let’s just love humans,” he says. “That’s the model of God’s will. And that’s a big driver of why I support CommonSpirit Memorial.”





Pink! 2026

The CommonSpirit Memorial Foundation’s 21st annual Pink! gala, skillfully chaired by Marc and Dr. Rachel Labovitz and Danny and Jennifer Waxenberg, generated an impressive \$1.3 million. This achievement contributes to a 21-year cumulative total of over \$9.4 million for the gala. Every single dollar raised stays within our community, directly supporting the vital services of the MaryEllen Locher Breast Center at CommonSpirit - Memorial Hospital. **We are especially grateful for the continued dedication of our presenting sponsor, Henderson, Hutcherson and McCullough (HHM), to the MaryEllen Locher Breast Center.**

The generosity of the sold-out crowd of 1,150 guests will directly fund critical advancements for patients. A key investment includes the purchase of two innovative stand-up stereotactic biopsy machines, destined for the Chattanooga and Georgia centers. These machines represent a significant leap forward in patient comfort and access, especially for those with limited mobility, and will establish CommonSpirit - Memorial Hospital’s MaryEllen Locher Breast Center as the region’s first and only facility to offer this advanced technology. Beyond equipment, Pink! proceeds remain dedicated to supporting indispensable programs: funding for dedicated nurse navigators, expanding our mobile mammography coaches, and providing college scholarships for children affected by breast cancer.

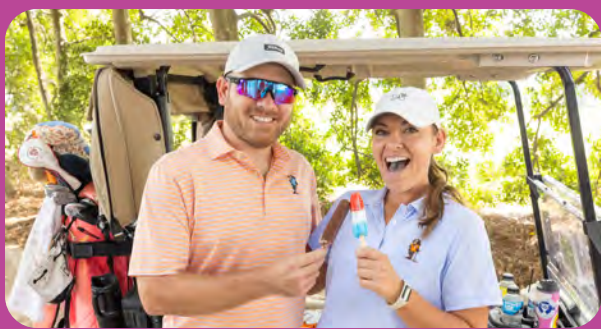

Laura Kay

Dignity in Diagnosis



Laura Kay has depended on a piece of equipment for 48 years after losing the use of her legs. Even as her wheelchair has given her mobility, another machine has offered security through her breast cancer journey.

The MaryEllen Locher Breast Center's stereotactic breast biopsy machine provided comfortable care for Laura as she navigated her diagnosis with breast cancer. The machine allows women to stay seated instead of lying down for a biopsy. This is especially helpful for women with back pain and limited mobility. The machine was funded through Pink!, the annual gala sponsored by the CommonSpirit Memorial Foundation.

"The stereotactic machine was a game-changer for me and people in my situation," Laura says. "I felt safe in the chair, and I didn't have to worry about being in a difficult position. It gave me some dignity. I was able to get in it with a little assistance from my husband."

Laura praises the breast center staff who work with the biopsy machine. "It's a nerve-wracking experience, but they just put me at ease," she says.

Laura became a paraplegic following a sledding accident as a teenager. She retired from Blood Assurance as director of software systems after a 41-year career there. She and her husband, Lee, are residents of Ringgold.

Laura's mother had breast cancer, so she has always been vigilant with mammograms. Her most recent one revealed a small growth. Breast surgeon Dr. Betsy Washburn recommended a needle biopsy. Following the biopsy's results, Laura was diagnosed with stage 1 breast cancer and had a lumpectomy.

Laura has trusted the MaryEllen Locher Breast Center for her mammograms for many years. She appreciates the care and compassion the staff has shown her due to her physical limitations.

"They've always been able to accommodate me in the chair to get my mammograms," Laura says. "They make me feel comfortable here."

Laura has valued the reassurance and personal attention provided by the breast center staff throughout her latest challenge.

"You come into this and you are scared and you have absolutely no idea what's going to happen to you," she says. "They are just a steady hand at every step of the process, explaining to you what they're doing."

The stereotactic breast biopsy machine is practical proof of the power of investing in the breast center, Laura maintains.

"You can give to different causes, but a lot of times you don't get to see the results of the donation," she says. "I want people who donated to this to know there's a physical piece of equipment that they can see that is making a difference in people's lives. It made a difference in mine."

MaryEllen’s personal battle with breast cancer fueled her desire to alleviate the educational concerns of families facing similar challenges, a mission her fund continues to uphold with forward-thinking support.

In its 24-year history, the MaryEllen Locher Scholarship Fund has awarded nearly 681 scholarships, totaling over \$1.4 million. This enduring legacy demonstrates a sustained commitment to fostering the next generation of leaders.

Mel’s Club

This program has delivered vital education to thousands of young women in regional schools, emphasizing the significance of early detection and proactive health practices. Amber Wade

A Mission Rooted in Compassion

As a child, Amber Wade lost her father to colon cancer. The tragedy brought more than grief; it brought the loss of her home, her security, and her sense of stability. Today, that experience fuels her role as a leader, volunteer, and board member for the CommonSpirit Memorial Foundation.

Amber's father, Richard Hixon, was in his early 40s when he received his terminal diagnosis. Soon after, the family faced a devastating series of losses, including foreclosure and eviction. "I remember going over there to get the rest of my stuff, and it was in a ditch," Amber recalls of that traumatic time. "All my books and my clothes."

Forced to grow up quickly, Amber channeled that resilience into a successful career, currently serving as the CFO for Serodino Inc. Yet, her heart remains with those currently in the fight against cancer. She is a tireless champion of the Joe and Virginia Schmissrauter Center for Cancer Support, which provides patients with financial assistance, transportation, and counseling.

For Amber, the Center is a sanctuary.

"There's a stark contrast between a sterile medical environment and this warm, cozy center," she says. "You feel like you are walking into your grandmother's house." Beyond the atmosphere, she recognizes that the Center provides something even more vital: hope. "You are giving patients and their families hope in a very hopeless situation," she explains. "It's so easy to feel helpless."

An avid runner, Amber found her calling by helping lead the River City Ribbon Run. Serving as co-chair for the 2026 event, she helped raise \$178,000—more than triple the previous year's total.

With her sights set on a \$250,000 goal for 2027, the self-described "competitive" philanthropist isn't slowing down. "If you want to make a change, you have to have a big ask," Amber says. "This is a noble necessity. You're helping people eat and stay in their homes."

For Amber, this work is a full-circle moment. "It happened so I can do this," she says. "Every dollar is helping people rebuild their confidence."

Dr. Vimal Ramjee

Innovation in Imaging



After decades of providing innovative service to patients, The Chattanooga Heart Institute remains committed to growth, and that includes cardiac imaging.

“We’re all here in service of a greater purpose,” says Dr. Vimal Ramjee, a cardiologist with the institute for the past 10 years. “There are many areas of The Chattanooga Heart Institute that are growing tremendously. What I’m most excited about is our potential and seeing what’s next.”

One of the newest tools for cardiac care at CommonSpirit—Memorial Hospital is the coronary CTA (computed tomography angiography). The process is done with a cardiac CT machine. Three new machines were purchased this past year.

The cardiac CT machine provides a CT scan of the chest that offers high-resolution, detailed images of the cardiac structure, including blood vessels that supply blood to the heart.

“In order to see those vessels in the past, we would have had to do an invasive procedure,” says Dr. Ramjee. “The coronary CTA is like a non-invasive heart cath using modern, sophisticated technology.”

Coronary CTA and other cardiac CTs “provide gold standard evidence-based care for our patients,” Dr. Ramjee explains. “This is a powerful test that allows us to bring cutting-edge technology to a community that has among the highest prevalence of coronary artery disease in the country.”

The cardiac CT machine produces results that are used across Memorial’s broad spectrum of heart care, including structural heart therapies, cardiac surgery, and aortic aneurysm surveillance.

Funds for two of the new cardiac CT machines were secured in part through the Foundation’s comprehensive capital campaign, and proceeds from the CommonSpirit Memorial Foundation Golf Invitational. By leveraging the collective purchasing power of CommonSpirit Health, Memorial was able to acquire two cardiac CT machines for the price of one.

Donors are key players in the success, growth, and longevity of The Chattanooga Heart Institute, Dr. Ramjee maintains. Not only do they provide vital financial resources, they are advocates for Memorial.

“We rely on and work in parallel with our donors because they’re just so important to our mission,” Dr. Ramjee says. “A big part of where I see a donor’s value is in being a voice. They know the work we do. They know the loyalty, the commitment, and the quality of care. Sharing that with others is a valuable way to make sure that people know where to go when they need high-quality cardiac care. Our mission is not possible without them.”

Dr. Ramjee is committed to Memorial because of its people and its passion.

“From the top down, it’s the culture and the people that make Memorial a special place,” says the cardiologist. “The quality is excellent because people really care.”

Memorial Volunteer & Auxiliary Services

“Generosity in Motion” accurately defines volunteers at CommonSpirit Memorial Hospital! Many volunteers walk up to 15,000 or more steps daily, escorting patients to offices or departments, listening to concerns, answering questions, and offering reassurance. Volunteers also serve in many other capacities on all three campuses, bringing their skills and interests to positions they enjoy.

This was an eventful year for Volunteer Services and the Auxiliary with (1) the retirement of the long-time director (see next page), (2) rebranding of the hospital as CommonSpirit-Memorial Hospital, and (3) the opening of a brand new hospital in Georgia.

With funds raised through special sales and the Cloverkey Gift Shop, the Auxiliary was proud to contribute \$30,000 over the past three years to the construction of the new hospital in North Georgia. They happily gave an additional \$2,500 to the stained glass window in the Sister Judy Raley Chapel, which welcomes people as soon as they come through the main entrance of the North Georgia hospital. Sister Judy was a beloved volunteer herself, in addition to serving the hospital in many other ways.

Other projects funded by the Auxiliary in the past year include the “We Care” Saturday retreat offering respite, entertainment, and support for cancer patients and their families. They also gave funds for the Comfort Closet, which provides free clothing for hospital patients who find themselves without appropriate attire at the time of discharge. Volunteers maintain this closet which is accessed 20-25 times a month by the Emergency Department or Nursing Services.

For the past 10 years, the Chattanooga Times Free Press has recognized healthcare excellence in Chattanooga in several categories. This year, Memorial volunteer Joyce Dick received the Champion of Healthcare award for volunteers for editing a newsletter that “provides the glue to keep the volunteers connected – especially during the pandemic.”

A total of 341 volunteers served 44,397 hours between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2025. That includes 56 students during the summer student volunteer program. The student program has been expanded across all three campuses, and many are returning for a second year.
